

<div style="text-align: justify">As you see the website JwForum.net has <strong>Google advertisement</strong> on the post area and Left Side.◆</div><div style="text-align: justify"><br /></div><div style="text-align: justify">Many brothers are surprised to see <strong>"unwanted"</strong> links from business products and other stuff.◆</div><div style="text-align: justify"><br /></div><div style="text-align: justify">I would like to explain that theses advertisements that you see there are <strong>posted randomly</strong> by "Google Ads" not me.◆</div><div style="text-align: justify"><br /></div><div style="text-align: justify">Google Ads returns the advertisement <strong>based on the following</strong>:</div><div style="text-align: justify"><br /></div><div style="text-align: justify"><strong>1 -</strong> Your physical location</div><div style="text-align: justify"><strong>2 -</strong> Your Internet Browser History</div><div style="text-align: justify"><strong>3 -</strong> Your most recent online activity</div><div style="text-align: justify"><strong>4 -</strong> The website/page content that you are reading</div><div style="text-align: justify"><strong>5 -</strong> Your age, genre and status based on your Google Account</div><div style="text-align: justify"><strong>6 -</strong> Cookies from visited websites stored in your computer/phone/device.</div><div style="text-align: justify"><br /></div><div style="text-align: justify">Please understand that <strong>Google focus on your browser history</strong>, cookies from others visited websites, recent online activity and searches terms/words to return ads that you might like to see and learn more.◆</div><div style="text-align: justify"><br /></div><div style="text-align: justify">The same ads you see on any other websites sponsored by Google. i.e. Youtube, Blogs, Forums, etc.</div><div style="text-align: justify"><br /></div><div style="text-align: justify"><strong>To avoid unwanted advertisements</strong> you MUST clean your computer cache and cookies stored in your browser.◆</div><div style="text-align: justify"><br /></div><div style="text-align: justify">Try this:</div><div style="text-align: justify"><br /></div><div style="text-align: justify"><strong>1. Clean your computer browser history and cookies and return to the website.</strong></div><div style="text-align: justify">You wont see the same ads again because your computer cache/history are clean.</div><div style="text-align: justify">Google will print new "ads" and will start showing ads based on your new online activity.</div><div style="text-align: justify">Google will collect your new online activity to return the most likely products that you might want to learn more about.</div><div style="text-align: justify"><br /></div><div style="text-align: justify"><strong>2. How to clean your computer cache:</strong></div><div style="text-align: justify">Try CCleaner to clean your your computer cache from old history and cookies.
